Getting these vaccines helps **protect you, your family and your community.**



COVID-19 can cause severe illness. The **updated COVID-19 vaccine** provides the best protection against COVID-19 infection.



Everyone **6 months and older** is recommended to get both the updated COVID-19 vaccine and a flu vaccine.



You can get your flu and COVID-19 vaccine at the **same visit.**
